Big Corkscrew Fire District Fire Station

Hole Montes provided professional engineering services to the Big Corkscrew Fire District for the creation of a new building that would house the local Fire Station. Hole Montes was able to construct a 17,700 square foot building that housed the new attached administration office as well as the truck bays and sleeping quarters for all staff. All of these elements are housed under one roof for convenience and quick response. In addition to this project, the Fire District also had Hole Montes conduct a rezone for them as “conditional use” in the future.

North Naples Fire & Rescue District

This project involved not only the design of a fire station, but also included a medical center. The equipment and personal for the fire station were housed on one side of the development while the medical operation was created on the other side. The station was a 7,300 square foot building that began on raw land.
