



Broad Avenue South Linear Park

Naples (Collier County), Florida

The scope of services was to design a conceptual plan to transform a barren, 250-foot right-of-way within a dense, residential neighborhood into a linear park, linking Naples Bay and the Gulf of Mexico.

The program included preservation and enhancement of the existing green space containing many mature trees; redevelopment of the space into a passive pedestrian pathway connected to existing systems to the east and west; design of paving, site features and furnishings; and elevation of the existing grade as decorative berm to offset enhanced water detention areas as visual focal points.

Hole Montes designed the landscape and hardscape redevelopment of the Broad Avenue South Right-of-Way Improvement Project from Third Street South on the west to Ninth Street South on the east.
