



Dearborn Street Widening and Streetscape

Sarasota County, Florida

Sarasota County selected Hole Montes, Inc. to redesign the four-laning of Dearborn Street in Englewood, Florida, between State Road 776 and Pine Street. The widening included an urban section with curb and gutter, sidewalks and bicycle lanes in a very narrow right-of-way. The existing bridge over Gottfried Creek was replaced by a precast bridge 85 feet to 90 feet wide and 90 feet to 120 feet long. The multitude of utilities within the existing right-of-way of the road added to the complexity of this project. Hole Montes designed new pedestrian (brick paver / concrete) access, landscape treatment, street lighting, and supporting drainage. The project included addition of pedestrian roadway crossings of Dearborn Street which were brick paver inlay with appropriate signing. This portion of Dearborn Street is also commercial/retail/tourism. This project was funded by the Englewood CRA. #1998.031
