



Extension and Widening of Imperial Street

City of Bonita Springs (Lee County), Florida

Hole Montes provided design services for the four-laning of Imperial Street in Bonita Springs, Florida, from Bonita Beach Road to East Terry Street. These two segments of Imperial Street both terminate at the Imperial River.

A new four-lane bridge was designed to span the 325-foot crossing over the Imperial River and its floodplain. The completion of this project was paramount to the completion of the Livingston Road / Imperial Street / Three Oaks Parkway project that, when completed, will be a significant north/south corridor for commuters in both Collier and Lee counties.

The roadway design incorporates an urban cross-section with concrete walks, bicycle lanes, and landscape buffer areas.

Additional services associated with this project included landscape architecture and irrigation design. The Landscape Architects and seasoned designers at Hole Montes provided the City of Bonita Springs and Lee County with a design that incorporates the beauty of native vegetation into the overall design of the roadway in order to give it a functional and aesthetically pleasing appearance. The landscape has not yet been installed on this project.
