Runway 6-24

Hole Montes managed the design and construction administration for the rehabilitation of Runway 6-24 (12,000' x 150') and parallel taxiway A and connectors. The project included converting the Taxiway into a temporary runway to accommodate the runway rehabilitation. The project also included touch down zone (TDZ) and centerline lights for Runway 6-24 and edge centerline lighting, signage and enhanced marking for Taxiway A.



Terminal Expansion

Conceptual design of expansion to terminal building including 5 new gates, 5 remote hardstands, concessions, security checkpoint, ticketing and baggage handling. Proposed expansion will include 98,000 s.f. of building and 114,000 s.y. of additional apron.



Air Cargo Ramp

Rehabilitation of 30,000 s.f. of bituminous pavement on cargo ramp and two connecting taxiways involving milling and overlay. Project was phased to maintain air cargo operations and access to FBO. The project included treatment of shoulders with latex modified micro-surfacing system. The project also included remarking of the apron to maximize the number of aircraft positions and the efficiency of the ramp.
