



The Widening of Alico Road

Fort Myers (Lee County), Florida

The Lee County Department of Transportation (LCDOT) selected Hole Montes, Inc., to provide engineering, surveying and project management services for this extensive project that involved the six-laning of an approximately three mile stretch of high-traffic roadway from U.S. 41 to the intersection of Interstate 75.

Hole Montes provided complete design services for this extensive transportation project, as well as surveying, permitting and construction management services.

Although the original bid and DOT plans called for Hole Montes to design a four-lane road improvement, the LCDOT decided midway through the design stage that the project should be expanded to six-lanes. The LCDOT knew that the roadway would have to be widened in the next five to ten years to meet growing traffic needs, so they gave Hole Montes permission to design the expansion so the necessary six-lane construction could take place all at once.

Hole Montes utilized its Global Positioning System (GPS) expertise and the latest GPS technology to assist them in the right-of-way mapping for this project.
